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
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

Precious ones of the light, those of you familiar with my lifestream, those of you who know of my record as Paolo Veronese,¹ will recognize that I have some familiarity with painting, with art, and with sculpture. You will recognize that I have in my consciousness a great affection and affinity for those molding concepts of beauty that enable mankind to externalize a part of the God-design.

Precious ones, I reverently, then, this day, execute in spiritual artistry a portion of the divine design of cosmic motherhood, and I place it as a miniature shrine within the hearts of all expectant mothers upon this planet this day as my gift to life.

You, beloved ones, who have thought upon it, have recognized the great beauty of Mother Mary and other spiritual mothers. You have actually reveled in the thought of these blessed beings.

Well, precious ones of the light, consider, then, the gift that I am bestowing this day upon all expectant mothers.

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I am bestowing upon them a spiritual matrix that will enable them to tune into many of the thoughts and feelings of beloved Mother Mary such as she carried in her heart during the time of gestation of beloved Jesus.

This, precious ones of the light, will enable the more sensitive to externalize a greater measure of selfless devotion and spirituality into the precious lifestream that those mothers are carrying. Truly, beloved ones, there is much dissonance and discord reflected in so-called modern art, which causes the disturbed conditions present within the psyche of the artist to be expressed upon the canvas.

These conditions, then, beloved ones, take the form of engrams, as it were. And when individuals behold upon the screen this outpictured discord, it does not key a response within their being that is calculated to exalt their soul, but rather it pulls them down into the discordant trend of the artist unless they stand their guard.

It is true that mankind must today, and at all times until mankind's discord be permanently healed, stand their guard against the intrusion of discordant music, art forms, worded expressions, concepts, and even invisible thoughts.

Mankind must learn to stand their guard. And it must be the prerogative of every mother and every woman who shall bear a son or daughter to engender with her thoughts the idea of cosmic protection within that precious lifestream of Goddesign so that she may be able, blessed ones, to assist that lifestream through all the days of that individual's life to be a more perfect outpicturing of divinity upon the canvas of life.

To Honor One's Parents

Precious ones, some of you are aware of the statement made by Abraham Lincoln that he owed everything to his blessed mother. This is not a new concept, for many great men and small men (by mankind's judgment) have recognized all that they owed to their parent or to both parents.

Perfect Love Is Perfect Beauty Inherent within the God-Design

Blessed ones, that precious spark of life that is within you, which is your own Divine Self, may not be pictured upon canvas but it is pictured in life. It is apparent in the lines of character drawn upon your faces, blessed ones. When you have fear in your world, it etches into the lines of your physical countenance the appearances that we can so easily interpret as a manifestation of fear.

Bear well in mind, then, that perfect love casteth out all fear and torment.³ For perfect love is perfect beauty, and this beauty is inherent within the God-design made and created by God in the Beginning—God who created this perfect, tiny form, embryonic in nature, and who created that blessed threefold flame of your being, your Holy Christ flame, blessed ones. And it is your responsibility to expand that Holy Christ flame, that in perfect balance and beauty it may be upon the screen of life an active manifestation of the Christ principle.

Blessed ones, the tiny, infant body that you once wore was also a thing of beauty, created wondrously and fearfully made. Blessed ones, you must recognize this blessed body as an outpicturing of the mind of God and also feel that the pulsations of life within it are the voice of God speaking to you and saying unto you daily and hourly:

Be renewed in beauty. Be renewed in duty. Be renewed in responsibility. Accept your cosmic opportunity. Hear my voice calling to you and be all that I AM, all that you shall be.

Recognize Yourselves as Divine Ideas of Beauty as Conceived by the Cosmic Mother

Recognize, then, your privilege. Recognize, then, that this day is a day that God has made. Recognize that every day is a day that God has made especially, beloved ones, for you, each one.

Mankind are too prone to feel that they are alone, that they themselves are separated as an island from the consciousness of God and that God is not too concerned with them individually. This is not true. That which was created was created not only for the *allness* of God but for the *oneness* of God. Beloved ones, despair is only a human feeling, as are all emotions of human creation. They bring about conditions of chaos and disorganization. You, blessed ones, must free yourselves from human creation. You must take on *divine* creation. Divine creation must be a creation of beauty and must, then, be a joy forever.

I have reminded you of this in previous talks given to you, but I must this day reiterate it and state it again because of the valiant truth inherent within it.

The Birthright of an Immortal People

If mankind will recognize their divine rights, if mankind will recognize their divine privileges, if mankind will behold the matrix of the divine around them, they will no longer be subject to those outer conditions that are a part of human creation and human chaos. They will cast this aside as a shroud and they will embellish themselves with the garment of Christ-beauty and accomplishment.

These are far more than words, blessed ones. I am speaking of a tangible garment. I am speaking of a robe of Christ unity. I am speaking of a birthright of an immortal people who are here for a season in the schoolrooms of earth so that they might master the problem of their own identity and find in the identity of God, their own mighty I AM Presence, the identity of themselves masquerading for far too long as a human and appearing for far too long as a puny individual. Man must cast aside *all* that is of his human self and recognize that he does not lose his cosmic birthright by so doing. Neither does he lose in any way. For you can never, beloved ones, lose anything by giving all that was given to you back to the heart of God.

Truly, he who seeks to save his life shall lose it.⁴ But he who loses himself, even his identity, for the sake of obtaining his divine identity shall find it again, and in a more grand and noble manner, until the purposes of life shall be fulfilled everywhere as God intends.

Be What He Is, and You Will Find Your Freedom

Gaze not upon the appearance world, the misshapen bits of marble, the canvases smeared with the feeble attempts of man to paint. Gaze not upon mankind as the finished product. They are but in the embryonic state. You need not mimic or copy them, for they are still students in the schoolrooms of life.

Gaze upon the perfect pattern of the Master Painter, the Master Creator, the Master Builder, the Master Artist. See what he has wrought and be what he is, and you will find your freedom. You cannot find your freedom in the pages of earthly history but you *can* find it in the pages of divine identity.

Going back before the dawn of recorded history to your own divine identity, when it was yet a spark of the cosmic fire dancing within the heart of God, there, blessed ones, you can find it, recognizing itself as individualized in part and yet unseparated from God. It spoke, speaking the name of God, I AM. Each tiny spark spake thus to one another beholding the Self and said, "I AM."

This is as it should be today. Then there would be no conflict between your outer ego and your Divine Self. You would not be in conflict with one another or with your own mighty I AM Presence. You would be swimming with the

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current of life and moving down the great river that flows from the throne of God. You would be obtaining your freedom each moment rather than denying it, and thus you would be affirming the Christ consciousness of your birthright.

So it is and so it ever shall be that the law of life, the law of liberty, O Mother Liberty, is held within thy hand, cradled within thy arm, the great Book of Life that reads the law of freedom for each man's being. (1) Paulo Veronese (1528-1588) was one of the major artists of the sixteenth-century Venetian school, known for his development of glistening pastel hues and a technique of pigment preparation unsurpassed in preserving paint. His many paintings illustrated the steps of initiation on the path of Christhood. His most impressive work is the vast Marriage at Cana, which hangs in the Louvre.
